Loftus Stadium

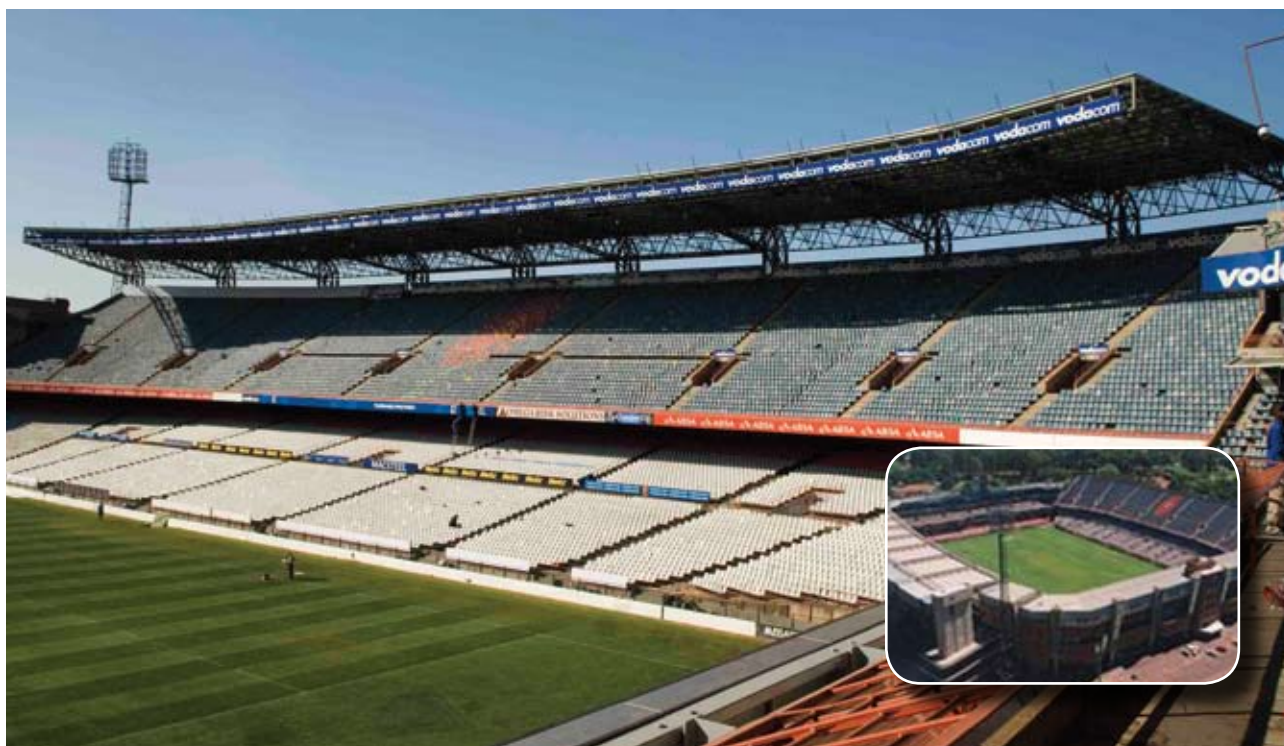
First used for sport in 1903, the 50,000 seat Loftus Versfeld Stadium in the heart of Tshwane/Pretoria has hosted numerous sports events in the last century including the 1995 Rugby World Cup and 1996 CAF Africa Cup of Nations.

Used as a 2009 FIFA Confederations Cup venue and the home ground of local soccer side Mamelodi Sundowns, Loftus – named after Pretoria sports pioneer Robert Owen Loftus Versfeld is now ready to host the 2010 FIFA World Cup games.

Free State Stadium

Deriving its name from the province in which it is located, the 48,000 seat Free State Stadium played host to CAF Africa Cup of Nations group and quarter-final matches in 1996 and the IRB Rugby World Cup in 1995.

The Free State Stadium in Mangaung (Bloemfontein) will be hosting FIFA World Cup teams at a venue familiar to the echoing sound of the vuvuzela as it is the alternate home ground of Premier Soccer League team, Bloemfontein Celtic.

Peter Mokaba Stadium

Inspired by the locally iconic Baobab tree, the 46,000 seat Peter Mokaba Stadium in Polokwane is named after one of the heroes of the struggle to bring about a new, democratic South Africa.

Holding much historical significance in South Africa, the design of the Peter Mokaba Stadium is largely concrete with the steel structure supporting the roof plane gathered together at each corner of the stadium and supported by giant 'trunk' structures which accommodate vertical circulation ramps and service cores.

Royal Bafokeng Stadium

Situated near Rustenburg in the Northwest province, the newly upgraded 42,000 seat Royal Bafokeng Sports Palace is host to many Premier Soccer League games and has been chosen as one of the stadiums for the 2010 FIFA World Cup.

Named after the Bafokeng people who live in the area and share in wealth generated by the platinum mining that takes place on their historical lands, the Royal Bafokeng Stadium has witnessed South Africa playing an earlier FIFA World Cup qualifying game against Bakino Faso in 2001 – which they won 2-1.
